SIGN OF THE CROSS & GREETING

Celebrant: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Rx: Amen.

Celebrant: ... be with you [all.] or: Grace to you...and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Rx: And with your Spirit.

PENITENTIAL ACT

Celebrant: ... let us acknowledge our sins, and so prepare ourselves to celebrate the sacred mysteries.

Rx: Lord, have mercy. Rx: Christ, have mercy Rx: Lord, have mercy.

Celebrant: May almighty God have mercy on us,

forgive us our sins, and bring us to everlasting life. Rx: Amen.

GLORIA **Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will.**

we praise you, we bless you, we adore you, we glorify you,

we give you thanks for your great glory,

Lord God, heavenly King, O God, almighty Father.

Lord Jesus Christ, Only Begotten Son,

Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father,

you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us;

you take away the sins of the world, receive our prayer;

you are seated at the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us.

For you alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord,

Wisdom is found by those who seek her.

(concluding the reading) Lector: The word of the Lord. Rx: Thanks be to God.

RESPONSORIAL PSALM: Psalm 63:2, 3-4, 5-6, 7-8

Rx: My soul is thirsting for you, O Lord my God.

SECOND READING: 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18 or 4:13-14

God, through Jesus, will bring with him those who have fallen asleep.

(concluding the reading) *Lector: The word of the Lord.* **Rx: Thanks be to God.**

[ALLELUIA] Rx: Alleluia, alleluia.

STAND

Stay awake and be ready!

For you do not know on what day your Lord will come. **Rx. Alleluia, alleluia.**

Matthew 24:42a, 44

GOSPEL: Matthew 25:1-13

Behold, the bridegroom! Come out to meet him!

Deacon/Priest: The Lord be with you. **Rx: And with your spirit.**

Deacon/Priest: A reading from the holy gospel according to N. **Rx: Glory to you, O Lord.**

(concluding the Gospel)

Deacon/Priest: The Gospel of the Lord. **Rx: Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ.**

People respond: Amen.

PREFACE

Celebrant: The Lord be with you.

Rx: And with your spirit.

Celebrant: Lift up your hearts.

Rx: We lift them up to the Lord.

Celebrant: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

Rx: It is right and just.

SANCTUS

ALL: Holy, Holy, Holy Lord God of hosts.
Heaven and earth are full of your glory.
Hosanna in the highest.
Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.
Hosanna in the highest.

IF KNEELING: PLEASE KNEEL IN PLACE AT YOUR SEAT

Celebrant: The mystery of faith.

Celebrant: Through him, and with him, and in him, ... for ever and ever. **Rx: Amen.**

The Communion Rite

LORD'S PRAYER AND FINAL DOXOLOGY

Celebrant: At the Savior's command and formed by divine teaching, we dare to say:

ALL: Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name;
thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses,
as we forgive those who trespass against us;
and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

Celebrant: Deliver us, Lord, ... the coming of our Savior, Jesus Christ.

People: For the kingdom, the power and the glory are yours now and for ever.

Celebrant: Lord Jesus Christ, ... Who live and reign for ever and ever. **Rx: Amen.**

Celebrant: The peace of the Lord be with you always. **Rx: And with your spirit.**

LITANY FOR THE BREAKING OF THE BREAD

ALL: Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us.

INVITATION TO COMMUNION

Celebrant: Behold the Lamb of God, ... Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb.

ALL: Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof,
but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.

PLEASE STAY IN YOUR PLACE UNLESS YOU ARE DIRECTED TO MOVE
USE YOUR PERSONAL HAND SANITIZER TO SANITIZE YOUR HANDS
TAKE OFF YOUR MASK AS THE EUCHARISTIC MINISTER APPROACHES YOU
AFTER REVERENTLY RECEIVING COMMUNION, PUT YOUR MASK BACK ON

PRAYER FOR THE COVID-19 CORONA VIRUS PANDEMIC

Dear God of all the living, you sent your Son Jesus to heal us from illness and sin.

St. Damien and St. Marianne Cope dedicated their lives
